### Gifted Overexcitabilities - Friend or Foe?

Overexcitabilities (OEs or intensities) can pose a challenge for gifted individuals trying to fit in at home and school. It is easy to interpret OEs as poor behaviour, or for them to attract a clinical diagnosis. It's important to recognise OEs as typical gifted traits (even strengths!), and to assist children in using them as a tool for learning, creating, participating in interests and more.
